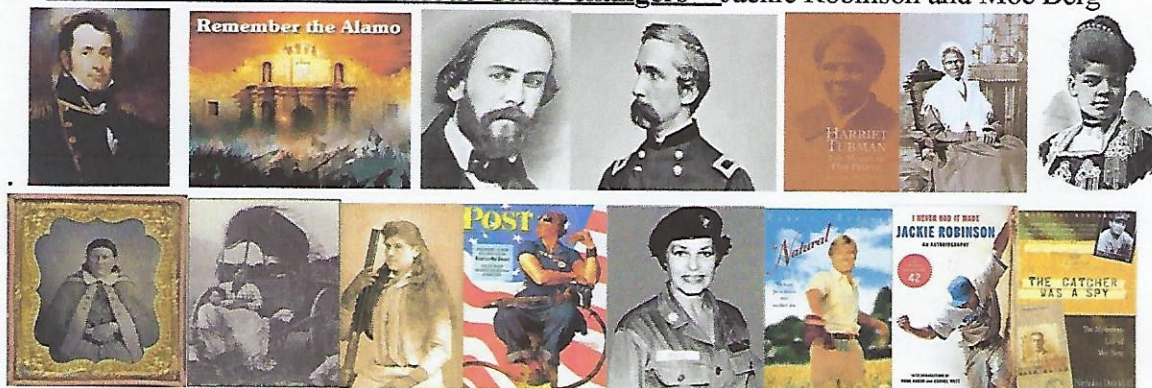


# **GAME-CHANGERS- PART II - Spring, 2018**
